- learn practical steps on how to abandon conventional land management practices that damage soil ecosystem and identify different beneficial and harmful organisms in the soil food web
- gain basic knowledge on how to make high-quality bioactive compost and learn to use compound biological microscope
 - examine soil and distinguish good compost from a low-quality one by using sensory and microscopic methods
- prepare compost extracts and examine them under a microscope to evaluate the success of compost / compost liquids
